

- 1. What has been the best part and hardest part of life since we last met?**

These symbols represent 9 basic functions of a Christian community we see in Acts 2:36-47. We will learn and practice these functions in this Game Plan. How can we be more like these first believers?

In the example to the left, the believers are practicing all of the functions of an Acts 2 Christian community. As you learn to obey Jesus' Game Plan for life, fill in the name of your group or church, and the functions it is practicing.

- 5. Read a passage from the Bible. See next page for reading list for each meeting, or choose another passage.**
 - Read the Bible passage
 - Explain the passage in your own words
 - Discover Jesus' Game Plan by discussing these questions about what you read.
 - What do we learn about God?
 - What do we learn about people?
 - SPEC? (S) Sins to avoid, (P) promises to claim, (E) examples to follow, or (C) commands to obey. (Sin is a biblical word describing an immoral act against God's standards.)
- 6. What will we practice?**
 - Have everyone practice retelling the story with a partner, or practice a tool you have learned.
- 7. What Game Plan goals will we set?**
 - How will you follow Jesus before our next meeting?
 - Who will you share the good news of Jesus with before our next meeting?
- 8. Pray and ask God to help you obey.**

<p>4. Pass it On / Make Disciples</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Game Plan: Matt 28:19-20 • Story: John 4:4-42 	<p>Action:</p>	
<p>5. Love</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Game Plan: Matt 22:37-39 • Story: Luke 10:25-37 	<p>Action: Make a plan to show love to another church or someone in your community before our next meeting.</p>	
<p>6. Worship and Persevere</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Game Plan: Matt 4:10 • Story: Acts 16:25-34 	<p>Action:</p>	
<p>7. Remember Jesus / Lord's Supper</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Game Plan: Matt 26:26-28 • Story: Luke 22:7-20 	<p>Action: Make a plan to use bread and the cup to remember Jesus regularly in your gathering.</p>	
<p>8. Give</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Game Plan: Matt 6:1-4 • Story: Mark 12:14-44 	<p>Action: Make a plan for how you will give together from now on, and how to use what is given.</p>	
<p>9. Gather</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Game Plan: Hebrews 10:24-25 • Story: Acts 2:36-47 	<p>Action: Name your group. If you are not in a spiritual community like this, connect with a Live Second coordinator to get connected or to start your own.</p>	
<p>10. Begin Long-Term Game Plan</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Continue to use this pattern through other parts of the Bible. Begin by going through the book of Mark passage by passage. 	<p>Action: Read through 1 Timothy 3:1-13 and pray that everyone in your group or church will grow in godly character.</p>
